Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

I. N-LIST

What N-LIST means?

An initiative of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) under the NME-ICT now funded by UGC, as college component under UGCINFONET Digital Library Consortium (now part of e-ShodhSindhu.)

INFLIBNET (Information and Library Network) is the nodal agency for managing the N-LIST Consortia where 6000+ ejournals and 135000+ ebooks (figures may change from time to time) are available.

Who Can Access?

Any authorized member of the library who has collected the username and password from the Librarian can access the N-List facility.

Can I access N-LIST from outside the College Campus?

N-LIST can be accessed from any corner of the world provided one should have internet connectivity and the username and the password which are provided by your library.

II. Locally Digitized In-house E-Resources

What locally digitized in-house e-resources means?

It means that the College library after formal authorization has digitally scanned the selected printed resources either from its own collections or from external printed resources. At present the resources are available within the LAN (Local Area Network) coverage of the Central Library.

III. Open Access E-Resources

What Open Access E-Resources Means?

INFLIBNET defines it as “Open access is a publication model wherein neither a reader nor the reader's institutions are charged for access to articles or other resources. Users are free to read, download, copy, distribute, print, search, or link to the full texts of these articles”.

IV. E-Learning Platforms

What is E-Learning?

E-learning means teaching and learning through computer technology, network technology, mobile technology, e-media technology or any other electronic means or gadgets. E-Learning platforms is a kind of virtual environment where both the teachers and the learners communicate with each other
