

Skills Training Centre, Dhakuakhana invites applications from eligible candidates for admission to the Introductory Training Programme for the State Civil Services (ACS, APS etc.) Examinations 2019 to be conducted by it.

**Highlights of the Programme:**

- The entire course is **free** of cost.
- **Duration:** March 1 – May 31, 2019 from 11 A.M. to 2:30 P.M .
- **Venue:** Dhakuakhana College, Dhakuakhana.
- **Subjects:** General Studies, One Optional Subject.
- *Highly-experienced faculty drawn for reputed universities/colleges*
- **Eligibility Conditions:**
  - I. *Minimum education qualifications:* The candidate must hold a degree from a recognized university and must be a resident of Dhakuakhana Sub-Division.
  - II. *Age Limit:*
    - a) A candidate must have attained the age of 21 years and must not have attained the age of 32 years as on 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2019.
    - b) The upper age limit prescribed above will be relaxable -
      - (i) upto a maximum of 5 (five) years if a candidate belongs to Scheduled Caste (SC) or Scheduled Tribe (ST) community.
      - (ii) upto a maximum of 3 (three) years in the case of the candidates belonging to Other Backward Classes(OBC).  
who are eligible to avail of reservation applicable to such candidate.
  - III. General candidates securing minimum 55 per cent and reserved category candidates securing minimum 50 per cent marks in the Degree examinations.
- **Selection of Candidates:** On the basis of written test on General Studies (objective-type questions) to be held on **20<sup>th</sup> February, 2019** from **11 A.M. to 1 P.M.**  
All the questions in the selection test will be from the General Studies paper of the APSC syllabus. Maximum marks for the paper will be 200. The total number of questions will be 100. (All multiple choice with no negative marking).

- **Venue for the Written Test:** Dhakuakhana College, Dhakuakhana.  
Any change in the date and venue of the selection test will be duly notified in the website of Dhakuakhana College, Dhakuakhana ([www.dhakuakhanacollege.org](http://www.dhakuakhanacollege.org)).
- **Date of declaration of the results of the Selection Test:** 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2019 at 3 P.M. Result will be displayed in the notice board of Dhakuakhana College and also the website of the college ([www.dhakuakhanacollege.org](http://www.dhakuakhanacollege.org)). If, in case of any unforeseen circumstances, the results are not declared on that day, the same will be intimated to the candidates on the website specified.
- **Reservation** of seats for ST(H), ST(P), SC and OBC as per Government rules.
- The training programme will be non-residential and no hostel accommodation will be provided to the candidates.
- **Last date for submission of forms:** 5<sup>th</sup> February, 2019. No applications will be entertained after the last date.
- Application forms can be collected from the office of the Principal, Dhakuakhana College during the office hours. Application forms can also be downloaded from the website of Dhakuakhana College ([www.dhakuakhanacollege.org](http://www.dhakuakhanacollege.org)).
- The candidate has to submit self-attested copies of all relevant testimonials with two colour passport-sized photographs along with the application form.
